Information will be taken to the SAR Panel for discussion and agreement relating to whether the criteria has been met for a SAR

Consider if case meets SAR criteria (see points below):-

- An adult in its area dies as a result of abuse or neglect, whether known or suspected and there is concern that partner agencies could have worked more effectively to protect the adult.
- If an adult in its area has not died, but you believe the SAB should consider if the adult has experienced serious abuse or neglect.

Does it meet Section 42 of the Care Act 2014 criteria?

- Has care & support needs &
 - Is experiencing or is at risk of abuse or neglect &
- Is unable to protect themselves because of their care & support needs.

If disagree return to referrer

Review identifies issues that require further enquiry

Safeguarding Plan

- Plan is person centred & outcome focussed.
- Plan is proportionate & least restrictive.
- Timescales for review & monitoring of plan are agreed.
- Lead professional for monitoring & review of plan agreed.
- All involved are clear about their role & actions.

Review of Safeguarding Plan

Evaluate effectiveness of the Safeguarding Plan, of outcomes achieved, and levels of current/ongoing risk Professional discussion – if unsure then discuss the case with one of the following:-

- Safeguarding Team
- Organisations Safeguarding Lead
- Manager
- EDT
