<a href="#">Identifying Sexual Behaviours</a>	This innovative resource – sometimes known as the ‘Brook Traffic Light tool’ helps professionals who work with children and young people to identify, assess and respond appropriately to sexual behaviours

<a href="#">Clare’s Law</a>	This gives members of the public the opportunity to make enquiries about an individual who is in a relationship with, or who is in a relationship with someone they know, and there is a concern that the individual may be abusive towards their partner. If police checks show that the individual has a record of offences relating to abuse or if there is other information to indicate the person you know is at risk, the police will consider sharing this information with the person(s) best placed to protect the victim
<a href="#">The Glade Sexual Assault Referral Centre</a>	This is a service that is provided to all men and women who have experienced rape or sexual assault
